## **OFF-ROAD MOTORSPORTS HALL OF FAME CALLING FOR 2006 NOMINATIONS**

**RENO, NV** – (Jan. 29, 2006) – The Off-Road Motorsports Hall of Fame (ORMHOF), located at the National Automobile Museum (The Harrah Collection) in Reno, Nevada, has announced that it is calling for 2006 nominations from a variety of off-road groups, associations, sanctioning bodies, key industry contacts and event promoters who have outstanding individuals within their organizations.

Deadline for this year's nominations is March 15, 2006.

Categories for nomination are Recreational 4-Wheeling, Motorcycles and All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV); Competition of Motorcycles/ATVs, Off-Road Racing, Rally, Rock Crawling, and Sand Sports; and Pioneers who are Advocates, Industry Leaders and Journalists.

The nominator must submit as complete a biography as possible on each nominee. The more information provided on the nominee that fits the criteria, the better the possibility of selection for induction into the Hall of Fame.
